The blade employs a stiffer and more durable structure with a distinct texture and a slight taper from base to top. These features are designed to decreased overall mass weight while increasing stabilization and vane durability. The base of the vane is created from a softer polymer that has proven to act similarly to the time-honored Duravane, which are notorious for unmatched adhesion. What's more, the soft base also allows for the vane to react to contact or crushing more like a traditional feather, but with the resilience and weatherproof capabilities of a vane.
